



Strict Regulations Guide Landfill Operations

Modern Landfill has been in operation for nearly 50 years, providing safe and environmentally responsible waste disposal services for commercial, residential and industrial customers in central Pennsylvania and neighboring communities. We take great pride in what we do, and strive daily to meet the high expectations of our neighbors.

We also work daily to meet rigorous local, state and federal regulations that govern all aspects of siting and operations to ensure the facility is managed in a way that is good for the environment and protective of public health. Our team is up to the task. Our on-site employees have more than 350 years of combined waste management experience.

Modern Landfill has been operating under a Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) permit since 1978. We regularly monitor and report activities to DEP, which also inspects our facility on a monthly basis. Enforcement is strict.

Modern Landfill also enters into host agreements with the local municipalities where we operate. Host agreements are allowed — not required — by the state’s municipal solid waste management law. These agreements provide an opportunity for the township to negotiate benefits beyond the required statutory host fee.

Residents, businesses and manufacturers in our area generate thousands of tons of municipal and industrial solid waste on a daily basis. That makes Modern Landfill an integral part of the local economy — and we do our job as critical infrastructure to ensure responsible waste disposal options.
