Modern Landfill invests in the communities where it operates

YORK, Pa. (Nov. 5, 2020) – Modern Landfill values its long-term relationship with our neighbors, which is why our local team strives daily to return value to the communities where we operate.

Modern Landfill currently returns \$2.1 million in combined annual host fee payments to Windsor Township and Lower Windsor Township — and remains the single largest contributor to Lower Windsor Township’s budget, contributing more than one-third of all general revenues. Modern Landfill also is working on a revised host agreement with Lower Windsor Township, which now receives \$900,000 per year as well as other benefits, as part of the proposed Eastern expansion.

As an essential service, our dedicated team of professionals is focused on supporting our customers’ needs and meeting the high expectations of our neighbors. That’s because most of the 35 employees who work at Modern Landfill also live in these same communities. They are our employees, but they are your friends and family, too.

Modern Landfill’s annual payroll totals \$2.8 million, with generous benefits. But our economic footprint extends far beyond our borders. Our facility also relies on contracted hydrogeologists, engineers, groundwater technicians, stormwater technicians and laboratories, making us a driver for the local economy and a gateway for high-tech, science-based field applications.

Over the years, Modern Landfill has supported several local organizations and causes, and still does, finding ways to invest back into the local community. We value the relationships we have with our neighbors and local stakeholders, working tirelessly as partners with them to ensure our community remains the best it can be.
