### **Modern Landfill begins construction on \$20 million upgrade**

**YORK, Pa. (Jun. 15, 2022)** – Construction is under way on improvements to Modern Landfill's on-site wastewater treatment plant. **The overhaul represents an investment of more than \$20 million to enhance and upgrade the facility.**

The new plant is scheduled to be operational in mid-2023.

With work under way, we wanted to ensure our neighbors understood the activity they may see on site. **It's part of our commitment to keep you informed about our operations.** Performance Construction Co., a Quandel Enterprises company from Pottsville, Pa., is performing the work.

Everything is on schedule and advancing according to plan.

The treatment plant is governed by a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, which must be renewed every five years. Modern Landfill timely submitted its NPDES permit renewal application, which is currently being reviewed by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP).

In September 2021, DEP approved Modern Landfill's water quality management (WQM) permit, which authorized upgrades to the plant to meet increasingly stringent discharge limits under the current NPDES permit and any new or additional limits that might be imposed under the renewed NPDES permit.

Modern Landfill is highly engineered to protect public health and the environment, with protection of all water sources a priority. **These latest upgrades include installation of an advanced reverse osmosis technology that will greatly enhance the plant's performance and enable the facility to meet its latest permit limitations.**
