### Modern Landfill grants support local organizations

**YORK, Pa. (Aug. 11, 2022)** – Modern Landfill is committed to supporting the communities in which our employees and customers live and work. That means making sure local nonprofits and charitable organizations have the resources they need to fulfill their important missions.

Republic Services, which has owned and operated Modern Landfill since 1999, recently provided in-kind support to the fourth annual custom car and bike show at the Church of the Open Door to benefit the all-volunteer York County Veterans Outreach.

Created in 2013 to honor and serve hometown heroes, York County Veterans Outreach last year helped more than 30,000 local veterans with mortgage and utility assistance, child-care services, transportation to wellness checks, and so much more.

We take special pride in helping those who help others, including our local emergency responders.

Modern Landfill donated \$8,000 to the Craley Fire Co. to help them purchase new computer equipment to aid in responses and \$9,317 to Yorkana Community Volunteer Fire Co. for new firefighting equipment **in memory of the late Rod Weitkamp**, a 28-year landfill employee who also served as Yorkana’s longtime fire chief. (He was still serving as deputy fire chief at the time of his death Nov. 23, 2021.)



Over the last couple of years, Modern Landfill has contributed more than \$100,000 in grants and in-kind services to support local organizations and causes, finding ways to give back and return value to the communities where we operate.
