



Community Meeting on Water Treatment Plant Set for March 27

February 2, 2023

Residents can learn more about the \$23 million construction project.

YORK, Pa. (Feb. 2, 2023) – Modern Landfill is hosting a community meeting at 6:30 p.m. **Monday, March 27** in the gymnasium of the Lower Windsor Township Municipal Building to provide an update on construction of its new wastewater treatment plant and to answer residents' questions about the advanced technology being deployed on site.

The \$23 million plant is more than two-thirds finished and on track for opening later this year. Work began on the project in May 2022.



Modern Landfill has been treating wastewater at a permitted on-site facility since 1988, and regulatory oversight is rigorous.

Modern Landfill is fully compliant with a consent agreement it signed with the state Department of Environmental Protection in August 2020 to help kick off these improvements, which will greatly enhance the plant's performance and enable the facility to meet new permit requirements.

Upgrades include installation of massive water storage tanks (pictured above) and advanced reverse osmosis technology. These newer, advanced treatment methods also are recognized as capable of treating PFAS.

At the community meeting, residents will learn more about Modern Landfill's operations, its proposed expansion plans, its investments in the new wastewater treatment plant and updates on its construction and startup, and the company's ongoing commitment to protect public health and the environment.
