

Water Treatment Plant Construction Passes Milestone

The overhaul represents a \$23 million investment in enhancements

YORK, Pa. (Jan. 5, 2023) – Construction on Modern Landfill's new on-site advanced wastewater treatment plant is roughly two-thirds finished and on track for opening this year.

The \$23 million investment reinforces our commitment to operate the landfill in a manner designed to protect public health and the environment.

Everything is on schedule and advancing according to plan. Passers-by may not be able to see construction from the roadway, but there's a lot of activity happening on site, as it has been since work began in May 2022.

To meet ever-more stringent state and federal standards, these latest upgrades include installation of massive water storage tanks (pictured above) and advanced reverse osmosis technology that will greatly enhance the plant's performance and enable the facility to meet new permit requirements.
