Windsor Township celebrates grand opening of refurbished 'Windsor Wonderland'

RED LION, Pa. (Apr. 24, 2023) – Modern Landfill representatives joined Windsor Township officials, state and county elected leaders and area residents on Friday, April 21, to celebrate the grand opening of the newly refurbished "Windsor Wonderland."

In November, Modern Landfill donated \$30,000 to help the township finance a series of improvements to the community playground and surrounding environment at Freysville Park.

"It's important to us to find ways to give back and return value to the communities where we operate," said Modern Landfill General Manager Tim O'Donnell, who attended the grand opening. "That means investing locally to make sure municipalities have the resources they need for projects that will make life better for individuals and families."



Windsor Township used the \$30,000 grant, along with funding from the state Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, to replace the existing playground equipment at Windsor Wonderland while adding a rain garden and new stormwater controls to prevent playground flooding.

The original playground, which provides children with a place to exercise and play, was built in 1997. So, not only was the equipment dated, but it also had become increasingly difficult for the township to find replacement pieces when items broke or were damaged.
